



AGREEMENT

on the cooperation between

the Argentina National Institute of Industrial Property (INPI)

and the Danish Patent and Trademark Office

The Argentina National Institute of Industrial Property (INPI) and the Danish Patent and Trademark Office (hereinafter referred to as the Parties),

Being aware of the importance and necessity of ensuring legal protection in all fields of intellectual property in the further development of their intellectual property protection systems,

Recognising the advantage of bilateral cooperation and therefore desiring to strengthen this activity in the area of intellectual property protection,

Considering the great importance of the exchange of information relating to the protection of intellectual property between the Parties,

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

To the extent possible, the Parties shall keep each other mutually informed on the legislative developments in the field of the protection and promotion of innovative activities, as well as on the changes occurred in the organization of their offices.

Article 2

The cooperation of the Parties in the sphere of intellectual property may cover:

- a. Exchange of experience, including the exchange of experts, in various fields of interest,
- b. Exchange of experience in the field of protection and examination of trademarks,
- c. Exchange of experience concerning enforcement of intellectual property rights,
- d. Exchange of experience about commercialization of intellectual property rights,
- e. Implementation of bilateral cooperation projects on various matters related to intellectual property rights,
- f. Organization of common seminars, workshops and working meetings, e.g. on examination guidelines.

Article 3

Unless otherwise agreed between the Parties, all activities mentioned in Article 2 are expected to be financed via external funds and donor support. The offices will work jointly on obtaining the necessary funding for the given activity.

Article 4

The Parties should exchange their views and may explore the possibility of coordinating their international activities in all fields of intellectual property.

Article 5

Correspondence shall be carried out in English.

Article 6

The Agreement is concluded for an indefinite period of time.

Article 7

The Parties have the right to denounce the Agreement any time. The denunciation of the Agreement shall be done by notifying the other Party, in writing, at least three months before the wished termination date.

Article 8


The Agreement can be amended on the basis of mutual agreement between the Parties.
